"Yumemido" will serve as a food bank station (Tsurukawa, Machida)

Machida City is adjacent to Aoba Ward in Yokohama City, and people easily come and go to nearby restaurants and commercial facilities. In a residential area of Tsurukawa, Machida City, a mini private library "Yumemido" was opened in 2017 with about 2,000 books and is loved by children and neighbors.

The head of the library is a woman who taught Japanese at a private high school in Tokyo for many years, and she also runs a tutoring school.

From time to time, she also holds culture seminars for adults, attracting students from far away.

The owner of Yumemido has decided to become a partner of the International Cultural Communication Laboratory, and will serve as a food bank station.
