"3,000 packs of Yogurt" were donated

International Culture Communication Laboratory recieved a grant-in-aid from Welfare And Medical Service (WAM) in April 2021.

We ICCL are recognized by WAM as a grant funding organization and we work for the needy by using a subsidy. In order to distribute cold or frozen food, we need refrigerator car.

Thanks to WAM we could buy refrigerator car in summer, but it took time to look for the appropriate car within a budget. One of the friends introduced car dealer in Yamanashi Prefecture. We went there to negotiate and finally got.

Soon after getting the car, 3,000 packs of Yogurt were donated to ICCL and we delivered them to the elderly facilities, children's cafeterias and 10 places more. Since the mileage on this used car is 280,000 km, it needs repair sometimes. But we are happy with this car bringing foods in ideal temperature.
